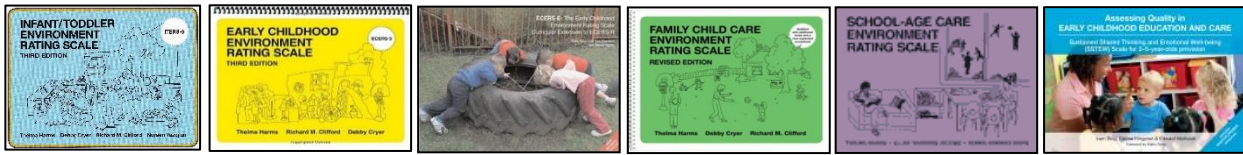


What is the UK ECERS Network?



The UK ECERS Network is a peer support group for local authorities, teaching schools and other organisations using the Environment Rating Scales to support quality improvement*.

The aim of the network is to share good practice in use of the Environment Rating Scales, as well as to provide a broader forum for supporting quality improvement work. Typical meetings include presentations from members on their quality improvement work, research and policy updates, time for discussion and sharing of good practice, and workshops on specific ERS-related topics.

The group is convened by A+ Education Limited. Membership is currently free, and there is no charge to attend meetings. However, we do depend on members to host meetings and attendee contributions towards the cost of lunch and refreshments.
